54

Field telephone buzzes.

CLOSE ON: WALL CLOCK: 12:42 A.M.

55 INT. TOC OBSERVATION PLATFORM - SAME

NICK FRAGOS peers through view port. Trip flare on southeastern perimeter bursts into bright white light startling him.

Shocked by what he sees.

Two NVA soldiers wearing camouflaged pith helmets and khaki uniforms calmly clip CAMP's razor wire. TANK idles behind. TANK commander shines spotlight around CAMP. Two more TANKs move up.

BRU open fire killing the two enemy soldiers.

CLOSE ON: FRAGOS.

FRAGOS

Why don't you just roll over the wire?

56 EXT. NVA TANK - SAME

NGHIEM sees his two soldiers fall in hail of tracer fire. Extinguishes his spotlight. Drops down, shuts hatch.

NGHIEM

(in Vietnamese, subtitled)
Driver, forward!

TANK bucks, bulls ahead.

57 INT. TOC OBSERVATION PLATFORM - SAME

FRAGOS cranks field telephone, hollers into handset.

FRAGOS

We have tanks in the wire! Get me some illume!

FRAGOS jumps from deer stand, meets SCHUNGEL cresting the TOC stairs.

SCHUNGEL

Show me what we've got.

(hollers down the

staircase to WILLOUGHBY)

Call for air and artillery on LANG TROAI ROAD! Get a flareship in here now!
